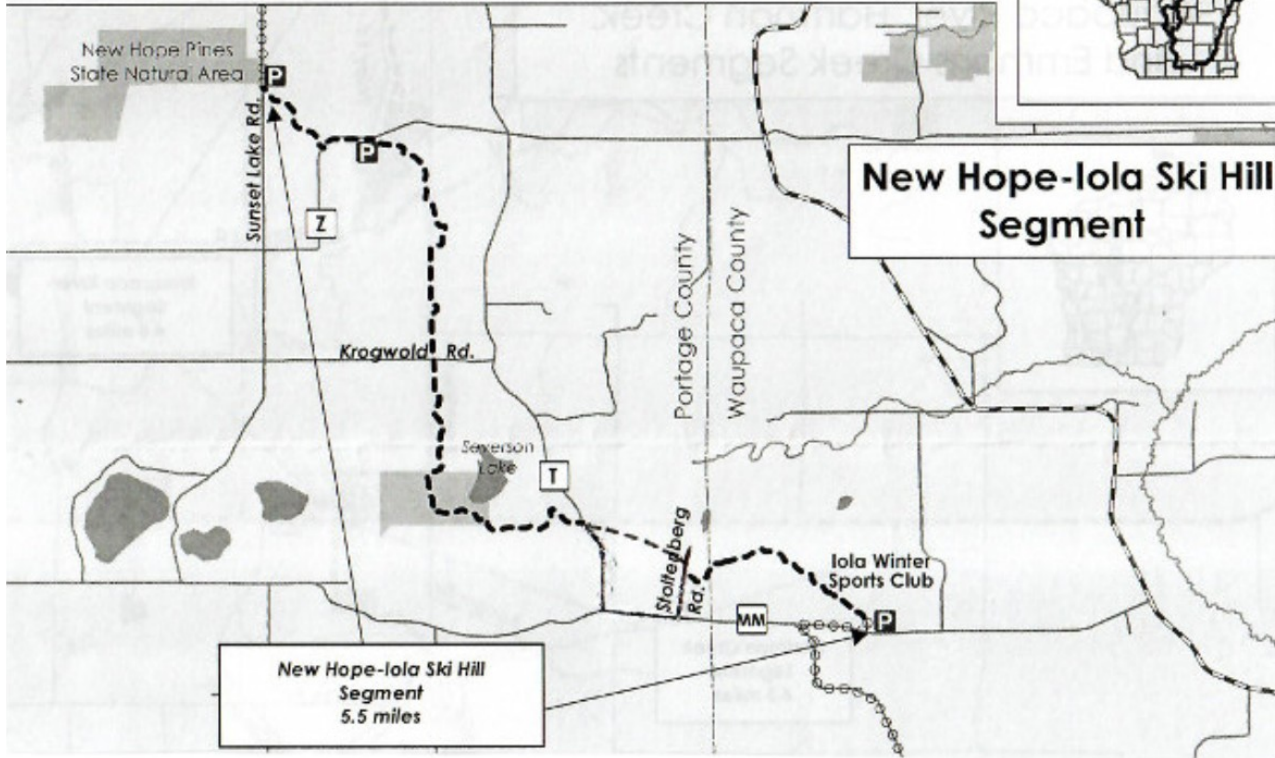


Ice Age National Scenic Trail Portage/Waupaca Counties

Iola Winter Sports Club - E398 County Hwy MM, Iola

From Iola: Hwy 49 north of Iola 5.5 miles to County Hwy MM, west 1.6 miles to Iola Winter Sports Club.

From Stevens Point/Plover: Hwy 10 east to Hwy 161. Travel east on Hwy 161. Turn left (north) on County Hwy A to County Hwy MM. Turn right on County Hwy MM 3.5 miles to Iola Winter Sports Club.
